## 10.1. PRESENTATION: Proposed Budget Overview 2017-2018 (Supplement)

Mr. Mark Keriakous, Associate Superintendent of Business Services will provide an overview of the Proposed Budget for the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year.

The Education Code requires school districts to adopt a budget and submitted to the County Office no later than July 1<sup>st</sup> of each fiscal year. The Adopted Budget reflects the estimated actual expenditures through June 30, 2017 along with the adopted budget for 2017-18.

This proposed budget was developed using the state-adopted Criteria and Standards. It includes the expenditures necessary to implement the Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) and annual update to the LCAP that will be effective for the budget year. Upon the Board's approval, the budget will be filed and adopted subsequent to a public hearing by the governing board of the school district pursuant to Education Code sections 33129, 42127, 52060, 52061, and 52062.
