Approval of Single Plans for Student Achievement for Carmela School. Lake Marie School, Loma Vista School, Los Altos School, Monte Vista School, McKibben School and Graves Middle School (supplement). Annually the Single Plans for Student Achievement are brought to the Board of Trustees for approval. An updated summary page indicating changes made to each plan since the last Board approval is provided in this supplement. The Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) and our Single Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA) must be consistent with the strategies included in the SPSA. Education Code 52052 states that specific actions included in the LCAP or the annual update of the LCAP must be consistent with the strategies included in the submitted school plans pursuant to EC 64001. All Principals have collaboratively worked together to incorporate the five LCAP goals into their SPSA. In addition to the five goals the action, services and metrics that will be used to measure student progress have been imbedded into the plans. All Principals have involved their School Site Councils in the further development and approval of the SPSAs. The plans include reference to academic outcomes for low income, English Language Learners and another significant subgroups. A clear relationship between goals for both plans is essential for strategic focus, transparency and monitoring.
