CALL TO ORDER	The meeting was called to order by Trustee Avila at 6:15 p.m.

FLAG SALUTE	The flag salute was led by McKibben School principal, Jose Alarcon.
PUBLIC COMMENTS	It was brought to the Boards' attention that there were inaccuracies with some classified employees' pay warrants.
	Joe Duardo addressed the Board and administration about a proposed collaboration between the South Whittier School District with the Whittier Union High School District and Rio Hondo College to form a partnership for STEM (science, technology, engineering, math) Education. Mr. Duardo is on the planning committee and encouraged administration to promote STEM education in the South Whittier School District.
COMMENTS BY TRUSTEES	Board members reported they had attended several Back to School Night activities saying they were well organized and well attended. They all enjoyed visiting the classrooms, meeting teachers and parents. They also reported they had attended the South Whittier Education Center/Rio Hondo College satellite campus opening. They had an opportunity to explore the campus and receive information from the various speakers. Board members are very excited about the educational opportunities available at this campus for the South Whittier community. At the earlier held Board Workshop, the Board received a STAR Test accountability progress report. Trustee Avila said she appreciated everyone's hard work in administering the tests and in relaying the data to the Board.

REPORTS	Dr. Kwek stated the district is dealing with many changes in salaries and with employee changes district wide. He apologized for the inaccuracies in pay warrants. The district will make the corrections.
	The Superintendent thanked Joe Duardo for the STEM information and stated the district is very interested in being a part of the STEM consortium.
	Dr. Kwek is part of a CSBA Superintendents Advisory Group. This group met in Sacramento and discussed recent events dealing with the executive director. CSBA asked the superintendents for input on the steps to take and how to proceed in pursuing the replacement in this position. Prior to recruiting and hiring the next executive director an internal governance review will be conducted. Dr. Kwek supports CSBA and the many services and programs they provide to school districts.
	The Jobs Bill was approved. The district has been informed that approximately \$695,000 will be forwarded to offset job losses and future job losses.
	The district had projected a loss of 80 students in the 2010-2011 school year. The actual enrollment drop is 174 students. Adjustments are being made in staffing.
